

Mexican Long Haul Carrier Eligibility Requirements

(04/07/2008)

To be eligible for C-TPAT, the Long Haul Highway Carrier must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Be an active Long Haul Highway Carrier in Mexico.
2. Does not cross the U.S. border, but transports cargo destined to the U.S.
3. Have an SCT Number issued by the Secretaría de Transportes y Comunicaciones (Mexican Department of Transportation).
4. Have a designated company officer that will be the primary cargo security officer responsible for C-TPAT.
5. Commit to maintaining CBP's C-TPAT supply chain security criteria as outlined in the C-TPAT Mexican Long Haul Carrier agreement.
6. Create and provide CBP with a C-TPAT supply chain security profile, which identifies how the Mexican Long Haul Carrier will meet, maintain and enhance internal policy to meet the C-TPAT Mexican Long Haul Carrier security criteria.
